camp. In an emergency breastfeeding saves lives, but sometimes that is not possible. Untargeted, donated infant formula often arrives to the camp damaged, expired, and contaminated.

We know donations come from a place of helping and compassion, but what other choices can we make to better help in this situation?











The Cluster and partners work with mothers and families to identify their needs. Nonbreastfed infants require specific, targeted support – untargeted donations of infant formula can cause illness and death. In an emergency, money donated to partners allow for a coordinated and appropriate response.
